Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Many of you have called or written to me to ask what the status of Haiti is at this time. Thanks to those of you that mission with us and have been so faithful to the Lord with prayer and financial support while Haiti is going through this hard time. You all know inflation is at an all-time high. The hell of Haiti is not only the cost of living, but also the development of armed gangs increasing violence, assassinations, and kidnapping.

The 2010 earthquake in Haiti left tens of thousands of children orphaned. Today they have grown into young people fighting desperately to survive. A large number fled to the Dominican Republic and live in sugarcane towns known as “bateyes”. In these camps, life is brutal for them just as it is in Haiti; except they are not constantly attacked by armed gangs or forced to join the gangs against their will. During the last three years, many parents who were small business retailers, also fled to the Dominican Republic to save their family.

In September Ministry in Mission will travel to the Dominican Republic to visit some of these camps. Joining with a small group of Haitian Americans that have visited the bateyes in the past will help us understand the urgency of solidarity with these people, constantly on their knees before God, hoping for divine intervention. As we better understand the needs, we plan to organize missions containing medical assistance, food distribution, clothing, school materials, etc. in the camps located in Puerto-Plata, DR. Ministry in Mission understands your interest in serving others. We take this opportunity to ask for your help, necessary to the success of this responsibility that God gives us, toward those who can't help themselves.
