A PLEA FROM HAITI

Ministry In Mission has quickly responded to the needs of those affected by the 7.2 magnitude earthquake in Haiti. Through Rev. Marky Kessa, Pastor of the First Evangelical Lutheran Church of Jacmel Haiti, Ministry In Mission sent funds for search and rescue teams and medical teams. The teams are driving to Les Cayes, a city hit very hard by the earthquake. The medical team is comprised of Haitian doctors and nurses.

In addition, funds were sent for an extended vacation bible school for the children of Jacmel. The children need the support of the church to help calm the fears that have been caused by the earthquake. People are more open to receiving the Good News of Jesus Christ during a disaster. The orphans and elders that we support are all physically fine.

Many of you know Rev. Paul Toulotte from your visits to Les Cayes, Pastor Toulotte's leg was injured and his home significantly damaged by the earthquake. Pastor Toulotte is pictured below.

We are also working closely with The Lutheran Church Missouri Synod Disaster Relief (LCMS) and the LCMS Director for The Caribbean and South and Central America to formulate a plan to help our brothers and sisters in Christ with food, water, and medical attention and the rebuilding of Pastor's homes.
